# Title of first page

This is an example of a  $\text{\LaTeX}$  `itemize` list

- first line in an itemized list
- second line in an itemized list
- third line in an itemized list

## Title of second page\*

The second page with nested, “vertically compressed” lists using the `citemize` and `cenumerate` environments.

- first line in an itemized list
- second line in an itemized list
  1. first line of numbered list
  2. second line of numbered list
- final line in itemized list<sup>†</sup>

For footnotes, the `footmisc` package, providing the options `perpage` and `symbol`, is recommended.

\* footnotes are often not a good idea for a presentation <sup>†</sup> ... it is therefore useful to write comments into a single footnote paragraph in order to save space

## Title of third page

**environment name:** `cdescription`, comparable to L<sup>A</sup>T<sub>E</sub>X's `description` environment

**used for:** vertically compressed lists with small “titles”
